

Care & Maintenance

Caring for your new hardwood floor is easy

What you should do:

- Clean regularly with a soft broom or dust mop.
- Vacuum using the bare floor setting.
- Clean floors periodically with professional wood flooring cleaning product based on the finish you use.
- Wipe up spills immediately.
- Use throw rugs at doorways
- Use felt protectors on furniture.

What you should not do:

- Do not use wet mops or steam mops,
- Do not use vinyl or tile cleaning products on wood floors.
- Do not use wood furniture polish.
- Do not slide heavy furniture.
- Do not walk on floors with sport cleats & high heels.
- Do not forget to trim pet's nails.



Maintain adequate humidity of 35% - 50% and temperature of 60° - 80° Fahrenheit.

Recommended Maintenance Schedule

Daily

Sweep or Dust Mop

Weekly

Vacuum using the bare floor setting

Monthly

Clean with recommended wood flooring cleaner based on finished used.

Every 3-5 years

Maintenance Coat depending on finish

Every Few Decades:

Sand & Refinish

Individual maintenance schedules will vary depending on use, type of finish, and lifestyle.
